Beg. at a stone Mid. The N. E. Cor. sec. No 20 Blk No. 206 T & St L Ry Co. a rock set on end marked K III. Th. S. 1900 ps to a large red rock set on end marked K IIII The N. E. Cor. sec. No 21 Blk No. 206 T & St L Ry Co. Th. E. 1900 ps to rock Mid. marked L. Thence East 1900 ps to large rock Mid.
