Norton deceased and George W. Norton and Martha H. Norton and Minnie Caldwell Lucy Norton Mattie Norton Juliette N. Marvin J. B. Marvin, Susan M. Coleman and John Coleman do have and recover of and from the Defendants H. W. Jacoby and Adolph Jacoby, the title and possession of the lands described in Plaintiffs petition being Twelve Hundred and Eighty acres of land situated in Concho County Texas. The Louisa Robbins Survey Number one Patent No. 133 Vol. No. 35 patented to C. C. F. Blanchard assignee bounded as follows:
