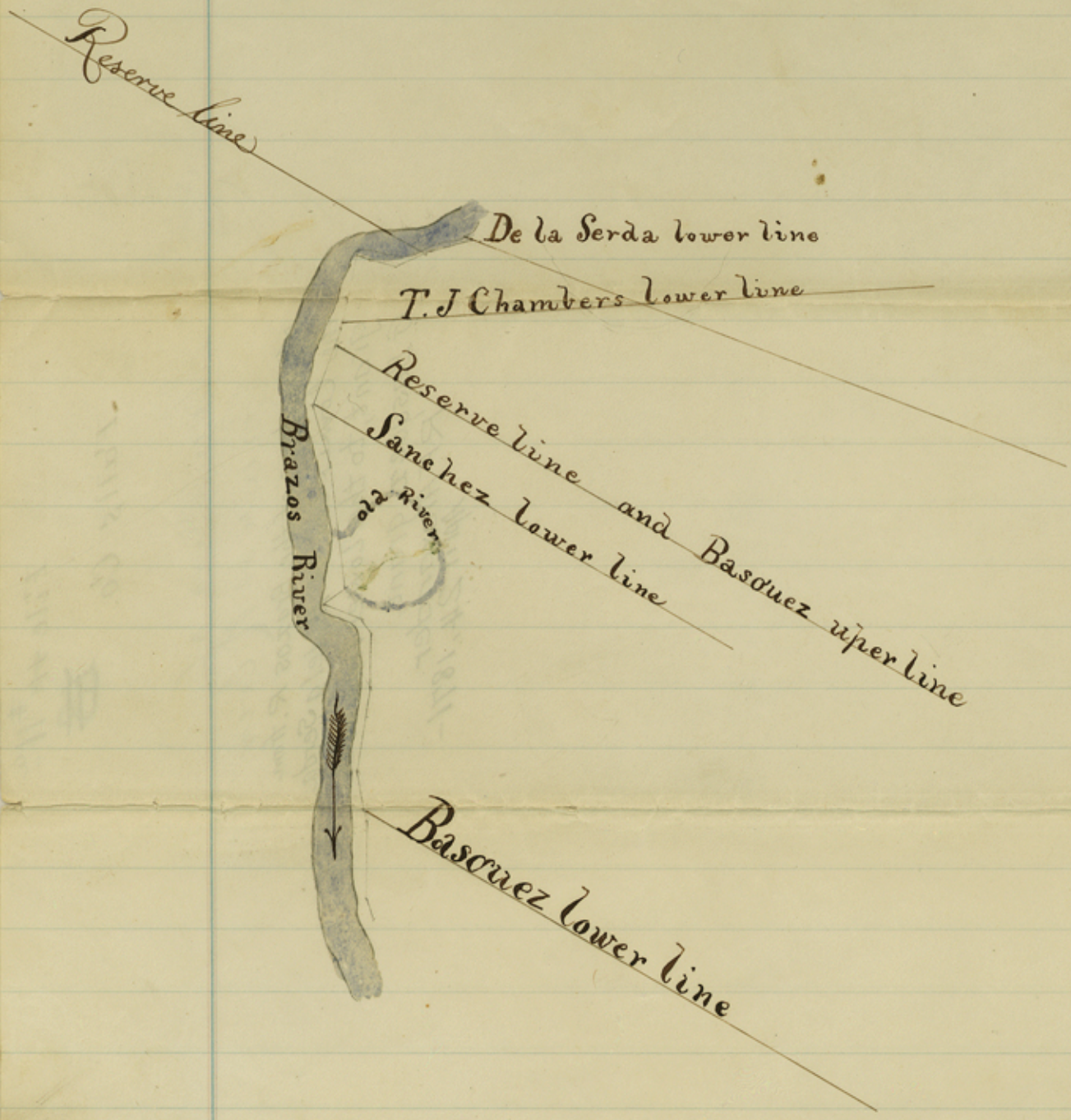

I also certify that I have at some former time measured the distance from the lower line of the De la Serida Grant to the lower line of the upper or lower league Grant of Gregorio Baquey above and know it to be 14254 ore
