Beginning at a pile of rock
the S. E. corner of Sect. 173. from which two
Hawthorps bearing S 81° E. mhd x

Then due West 450 ft. cross Grosbeak.
Brock at 1900 ft. a rock mound. Then North
1900 ft. a rock mound. Then North 440 ft. cross
N. Grosbeak at 1900 ft. a rock N. E. corner Sect.
199. Then East 3800 ft. an earth mound from
which a Hawthorn to NW 64^o Hhd and another to
S 34^{1/2} W. 870'. N. E. corner of Sect 171. Blk. H.

Then East 3840 ft. a point on South Bank
of Red River. Then North from N. E. corner of 171,
41400 ft. S. Bank of Red. River.

Beginning at a rock mound the N. E.
corner of Sect 199. Then West 1845 ft. road to
Initial Mon. 1900 ft. a dirt mound & 4 pits S. E. cor.
of Sect 203. Then West 800 ft. cross Grosbeak.
Leave S. E. at 1900 ft. I stated a mound for S. E. corner
Sect 203. Then North 400 ft. cross branch 1209 ft. and
N. Grosbeak leave East at 1900 ft. a Mosquit 6" in
diameter for corner mhd x N. E. corner of Sect 203.
S. E. corner 233. Beginning at a Mosquit mhd x
6" in diameter for S. E. corner of Sect 233. Then North
250 ft. branch leave S. E. at 1900 ft. an earth mound
& 4 pits N. E. corner of Sect 233. Then West 1900 ft.
an earth mound & 4 pit covered with Cobble Stones
N. W. corner of Sect 233. from which 2 China trees

280' over Baker's Break at 1700' foot of high
range of hills at 1900' a rock mound on hill the

went over high broken ridge at 1900' a mound
& 4 pits in Valley the N. 2d. corner of Sect 337 and
N. E. corner of Sect 344. Then I went through Port
Oak Shinnery and Sand Hills 1900' an earth
mound 4 pits from which the south point of
a port Oak ~~tree~~ tree N $58^{\circ} 2d.$ a small mat of
same tree S. 27^o 2d. N. 2d. corner of Sect 344. a N. E.
corner of Sect 367. Then North 1900' an earth
mound 4 pits N. E. corner of Sect 368. from which
a lone port Oak 30" in diameter by S $44^{\circ} 2d.$ a bush
of Port Oak by N $16^{\circ} 2d.$ 300' Then I went 1900'
an earth mound 2 pits S. 2d. corner of 369. the lone

of Section 373. S. W. corner of Sect 368. Thence
South 1900 ft. over high thinney an earth mound
& 4 pits S. W. corner of Sect 367. from which 2 Post
Oak has N 55 1/4° E. a triple Post Oak has S 22° W. 2000 ft.
Thence South at 800 ft. wire fence 1600 ft. a point
from which stated a mound established by Surveyor
for S. C. corner of 375 has S. 86 1/2° W. 33 ft. abt 1900.
ft. an earth mound & 2 pits. Thence South 40 ft. a creek
at 186 ft. a point. Thence West 231 ft. an earth mound
& 2 pits from which a China Stump 18" in diameter
