





Photo #1 shows that at the Clear Lake end of the marina is a new L-shaped pier with new floating markers that indicate El Lago's property line. Photo #2 shows pilings in front of the old bulkhead.


New structures at the lake end of marina may need to be permitted according to existing bulkhead that lies behind this L-shaped pier. Also, the existing pilings in front of the old bulkhead will need to be removed, for these could be hazardous to navigation. There are two (2) floating platforms with pilings and a walkway at the north end of the marina, which is adjacent to Nasa Rd. I. These structures according to my 1985 aerial photo does not lie behind the old bulkhead. The new structures at each end of the marina needs to be checked to see if an easement will be needed. 

Please review the materials attached. Based upon the 1985 photo and surveying's overlay I don't think there is an encroachment at El Lago. If new docks, piers, etc. have been constructed that are not shown on this photo, and if you think they fall outside of the original shoreline as shown, send me a note and I will continue looking into the matter. Otherwise, we need to advise Hightower that we are closing the file on this matter.

There are several areas which Herman Forbes recommends we look into further. I have highlighted these areas and request that you do field inspections to document current conditions.

These are SUSPECTED encroachments only! If possible, I would prefer that you not even tell the property owners why you are looking at the sites until we have confirmation from surveying that state land is involved. I know you will be questioned by many of them, but we don't need them calling the Commissioner until we have something solid to go on from surveying.





Reference is made to the permit issued you on the above date for dredging in the above named waterway and hearing the above permit number, if a number was assigned.

Information is requested as to whether or not you have been maintaining and wish to continue maintenance of the channel, basin or other area for which dredging was authorized by the permit. If continued maintenance is planned you may sign below that statement at the bottom of the inclosed copy of this letter, insert the date and return it. If there is any part of the address that is incorrect, please show the proper corrections below the signature. If we have not received a positive reply within 30 days from the date of this letter we shall assume that you no longer wish to maintain the dredged area. In this case the authorization will be considered withdrawn and you will need to submit a new application that will be processed in the usual manner before any further dredging is performed in the area.

Prior to performing any maintenance dredging, further authorization must be obtained. Your request must be submitted in sufficient time to issue a public notice and perform other processing tasks. The normal period for receipt of comments in response to the notice is 30 days. Any request for a shorter period must be fully justified. A letter requesting authorization for maintenance dredging should include a proper reference to the permit that authorized the dredging originally.





(a) That the work shall be subject to the supervision and approval of the District Engineer, Corps of Engineers, in charge of the locality, who may temporarily suspend the work at any time, if in his judgment the interests of navigation so require.

(b) That any material designed in the prosecution of the work herein authorized shall be removed evenly and no large refuse piles, ridges across the bed of the waterway, or deep holes that may have a tendency to cause injury to navigable channels or to the banks of the waterway shall be left. If any pipe, wire, or cable hereby authorized is laid in a trench, the formation of permanent ridges across the bed of the waterway shall be avoided and the back filling shall be so done as not to increase the cost of future dredging for navigation. Any material to be deposited or dumped under this authorization, either in the waterway or on shore above high-water mark, shall be described or dumped at the locality shown on the drawing hereto attached, and, if so prescribed thereon, within or behind a good and substantial buildhead or buildheads, such as will prevent escape of the material in the waterway. If the material is to be deposited in the harbor of New York, or in its adjacent or tributary waters, or in Long Island Sound, a permit therefor must be previously obtained from the Supervisor of New York Harbor, New York City.

(c) That there shall be no unreasonable interference with navigation by the work herein authorized.

(d) That if inspections or any other operations by the United States are necessary in the interest of navigation, all expenses connected therewith shall be borne by the permittee.

(e) That no attempt shall be made by the permittee or the owner to forbid the full and free use ; the public of all navigable waters at or adjacent to the work or structure.

- (f) That if future operations by the United States require an alteration in the position of the structure or work herein an horized, or if, in the opinion of the Secretary of the Army, it shall cause unreasonable obstruction to the free navigation of said water, the owner will be required upon due notice from the Secretary of the Army, to remove or alter the structural work or obstructions caused thereby without expense to the United States, so as to render navigation reasonably free, easy, and unobstructed; and if, upon the expiration or revocation of this permit, the structure, fill, excavation, or other modification of the watercourse hereby authorized shall not be completed, the owners shall, without expense to the United States, and to such extent and in such time and manner as the Secretary of the Army may require, remove all or any portion of the uncompleted structure or fill and restore to its former condition the navigable capacity of the watercourse. No claim shall be made against the United States on account of any such removal or alteration.
- (g) That the United States shall in no case be liable for any damage or injury to the structure or work herein authorized which may be caused by or result from future operations undertaken by the Government for the conservation or improvement of navigation, c : for other purposes, and no claim or right to compensation shall accrue from any such damage.

(h) That if the display of lights and signals on any work hereby authorized is not otherwise provided for by law, such lights and signals as may be prescribed by the U. S. Coast Guard, shall be installed and maintained by and of the expense of the owner.

(i) That the permittee shall notify the said district engineer at what time the work will be commenced, and as far in advance of the time of commencement as the said district engineer may specify, and shall also notify him promptly, in writing, of the commencement of work, suspension of work, if for a period of more than one week, resumption of work, and its completion.

(i) That if the structure or work herein authorized is not completed on or before the thirty-first day of Decamber , 1965, this permit, if not previously revoked or specifically extended, shall coase and be null and void.





PUBLIC NOTICE

Interested parties are hereby notified that application has been made to the District Engineer for a Department of the Army permit for structures and work in navigable waters in this Engineer District, as follows:

Name of spolicant. Boat Town of Texas, P. O. Box 324, Sesbrook loxas.

Location: Taylor Bayou, on the right descending side, ear its entrance into Clear Lake, central to a point approximately 2 miles west from Seabrook, Texas.

Character of work: The applicant proposes to maintain an existing boat lift, dredge a basin and construct bulkheads, boat sheds and wharves at the above location. A bulkhead would extend westerly 323 feet generally along the north shore line of a shallow cut-off area shoreward from an existing island, then southerly a distance of 264 feet and then northeasterly a distance of 331 feet to a point opposite the point of beginning. The area inclosed by the bulkhead including the existing island would be dredged to a depth of 6 feet at mean low tide. The material would be placed on shore. Boat sheds would be constructed along portions of the perimeter of the bulkhead.

The plans may be seen in Room 715, Santa Fe Building, Galveston, Texas, at any time between 7:45 A.M. and 4:45 P.M., Monday through Friday, or at the Corps of Engineers Resident Office at Fort Point, Galveston, Texas.

Any protest you have to make against the proposed operations from the standpoint of navigation should be received by the District Engineer not later than 28 December 1961. However, more time will be given when required if the request is received by the limiting date. If no comments are received by that date it will be considered that there are no objections.

The decision as to whether or not a permit will be issued must rest primarily upon the effect of the proposed work on navigation. The Corps of Engineers cannot undertake to adjudicate conflicting claims to property rights affected by the proposed work.





Ms. Bennett further indicated that the GLO wants the owner of the Marina, Mr. Gerret van S. Copeland, to apply for a State Easement on Coastal Lands and pay the customary fees in connection therewith. Naturally, the position we would like to take is that Mr. Copeland is the owner of the entirety of the property upon which the Marina is located. Enclosed for your consideration are copies of the following: U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Dredging Permit and related file correspondence dating back to 1961, the time when Taylor Bayou was dredged in connection with construction of the Marina, then known as Boat Town of Texas (you will note that the Dredging Permit reflects an island that was completely removed at the time of dredging); Aerial Photograph of the Marina; Survey of the Marina prepared by R.W. 
