In compliance with the request made in your letter to Mr. E. F. Noelke, dated June 23rd, regarding re-survey and field notes of thirteen sections of land in Block 6, and one section in Block 7, in the name of The H&T. L. Ry. Co., in Irion County made for E. F. Noelke, in June 1927, I respectfully submit certified sketches of the work; with the following statement of the work on the ground:

In making survey and preparing field notes of the following lands, I was furnished, by Mr. J. J. Goodfellow, Licensed State Surveyor, a map showing certain lines run, and corners established by him, and also a description of certain corners established by Captain Turner in a re-survey made for the H&T. L. Ry. Co. of said lands: to-wit: Sections Nos. 2-6-12-14-18-20-22-24-32-34-42-48-854 in Block 6, and section No. 68 Block 7, in the name of the H&T. Ry. Co. in Irion

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County, Texas:

Beginning at the N.E. corner of section No. 16, at a mound of stone as shown on said map furnished by Mr. J. J. Goodfellow, as an original corner; Thence South 1900 varas, find old mound of stone as described on said map as an original corner; Thence South 1927 varas, find an old mound of stone, perhaps the original S.W. corner of section 56 Block 10, S. P. R. R. Co.; Thence West 1900 varas, to a point 27 varas^s of old mound of rock, made for the S.W. corner of section No. 1, and the S.E. corner of section No. 2, probably established by Captain Turner in his re-Survey for the H. & T. C. Ry. Co., Beginning at said mound of large rocks; Thence North 1900 varas, establish the N.E. corner of said section No. 2, a mound of stone; continuing North, in all 3800 varas, find N.W. corner of section No. 16, as established by Mr. J. J. Goodfellow, a pile of stone 11 varas South of fence; I then ran East 1900 varas to the beginning;

Beginning at the S.E. corner of said section No. 2,

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Thence West 1900 varas find old mound of stone,
made by Capt. Turner for the S.W. corner of section
No. 2; bearings gone.

Thence Beginning at the S.W. corner of section
No. 6, Block 6, an old mound of stone in ravine, shown
on said map as ^{Pumpers} Baker's corner; Thence East 1900
varas, Turner's S.E. corner of section No. 6, an old
stone mound 35 varas East of ravine; Thence
North 1900 varas, establish the N.E. corner of section
No. 6, and the S.W. corner of section No. 12; a mound
of stone; Thence East 1900 varas to the S.E. corner
of section No. 12, find small mound of stone;

Thence North, 1900 varas, establish the S.W. corner of
section No. 20, a mound of stone; continuing North
in all, 3800 varas to the N.W. corner of section No. 20
make mound of stone 7 varas North S. E. corner of
old fence; Thence West, at 1900 varas, Turner's
N.E. corner of section No. 22, a mound of stone at
corner of fence; at 3806 varas, Turner's N.W. cor.
of section No. 22 and the S.E. corner of section
26, an old mound of stone;

Thence North;

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at 1900 varas, Thence N.E. corner of section No. 26, an old mound of stone; at 3800 varas establish the S.E. corner of section No. 42, mound of stone, at 5700 varas establish the N.E. corner of section 42, and the S.W. corner of section 54, a mound of stone.
at 7600 varas, Thence N.W. corner of section 54, an old mound of stone. Thence East 1906 varas establish the N.E. corner of section No. 54, a mound of stone:

Thence Beginning at the N.E. corner of section No. 55 and the N.W. corner of section No. 54, at said old mound of stone; Thence West 1918 varas to Thence N.W. corner of section No. 55, an old mound of stone near old corner of fence, as shown on said map:

Thence Beginning at the N.E. corner of section No. 26, at old mound of stone: Thence West, at 1918 varas establish the N.W. corner of said section No. 26, a mound of stone; I then ran on West 1900 varas and found Thence N.W. corner of section No. 26, an old mound of stone, from which a Mesquite 4 inches in diameter & b.s. 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " in. 26 varas.

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Thence Beginning at the N.W. corner of section No. 18, as established by Turner, and described on said map furnished me by J.J. Goodfellow, Survey, at an old mound of stone 7 varas South and $\frac{1}{2}$ vara East of corner of old fence: Thence West 1900 varas to Turner's N.W. corner of section No. 19, and N.E. corner of section No. 20, an old mound of stone: continuing West in all 3810 varas, to the N.W. corner of section No. 20, as hitherto mentioned:

I thus find an excess of 10 varas East and West in section No. 20; an excess of 6 varas East and West in sections Nos. 22 and 54, and an excess East and West in sections Nos. 26 and 42, of 18 varas:

For descriptions of sections No. 18-32 and 34 I used data furnished by J.J. Goodfellow, mostly in preparing field notes: The field notes of section No. 48, is signed by J.J. Goodfellow.

In surveying section 68, Block 7, H.S.T. b. Ry. 60 I began at the N.W. corner thereof at an old mound of stone, as shown on the map furnished me by J.J. Goodfellow, said corner supposed to have counter 27179

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been established by Captain Turner in his re-survey
for the H&T Ry Co: Thence East 1900 varas,
establish the N.E. corner of said section No. 68 in
the South line of a new fence, 37 varas East of
the S.W. corner thereof. Thence South 1900 varas,
establish the S.E. corner of said section No. 68, a
mound of stone 1900 varas West of the S.E. corner of
section No. 69, of said Block, as measured from an
old corner.
