My name is W. L. M<sup>c</sup> Gaughan, Commissioner of the General Land Office of the State of Texas and my name Chas Pressler, Draftsman in said Office the General Land Office of the State of Texas.

Interrog. 2<sup>nd</sup>

The fieldnotes and maps of the designation of the Central line of the Memphis, El Paso and Pacific R. R. Co. 16 mile reserve from the Eastline of the State to El Paso were filed in the General Land Office June 20<sup>th</sup> 1857. A map of the extension of the same line from Brazos river to the waters of the Colorado was filed in the General Land Office December 17<sup>th</sup> 1858.

Interrog. 3<sup>d</sup>.

The original survey N<sup>o</sup> 5 Block B Tex. & Pac. Ry Co. was made April 20<sup>th</sup> 1875 and its fieldnotes returned to the General Land Office October 7<sup>th</sup> 1875. Said survey was made within the 16 mile reserve. See Exhibit A for a certified copy of the original fieldnotes of said survey and Exhibit B. for a map of Parker County, on which original survey N<sup>o</sup> 5. Block B. is marked by a red border and the Southline of the 16 mile reserve by writing in red ink.

Co. in accordance with the provisions of an act entitled an Act to adjust and define the rights of the Texas & Pacific Ry Co. passed May 3<sup>rd</sup> 1873 are all situated within the 80 mile TX R. Ry Co. Reservation, they were surveyed and the field notes are dated say from November 1875 to April 31<sup>st</sup> 1876 inclusive.

A great many of the land certificates were issued to said company May 25<sup>th</sup> 1876 and October 6<sup>th</sup> 1876 and applied to the fieldnotes as above surveyed.

Should they be included in this report if dated the fieldnotes are dated after (the adoption of the Constitution) April 17<sup>th</sup> 1876
