

Beaumont April 24<sup>th</sup> 1840

John P Borden Esq

Sir Your communication  
of the 12<sup>th</sup> Feb came to hand a few week since  
and I was then ready to start to Austin with the Map  
of the County and concluded it was not best to send  
you a list of surveys as I could make it out  
in the City and receive the field notes myself  
I accordingly started and went as far as Jasper and  
was prevented from proceeding on the account of high  
waters. I shall now be at Austin with the map  
as soon as I receive the field notes of the Survey  
of the County and correct the Map I have not time  
now to draw a sketch of the map to send you this  
mail but will endeavor to send you one next mail
