Dear Sir,

I am inclosing herewith field notes to the South part of Survey No 3. in name of W. G. Thonita, and Survey No 72 1/2 W. P. Rice. State School land, lying between Block D. G. C and S. F. R. R. Co. and Block A. H. E. and W. J. R. R. Co. situated in the North West part of Sutton County. From an actual survey of these Blocks on the ground I find that they are considerably changed from the position they occupy on the official map, see inclosed sketch. showing these Blocks as I have placed them by actual survey. Referring you to the sketch and field notes you will see that I have placed the common S. W. corner of Survey 23 and 9224 G. C. and S. F. R. R. Co. in North line of Survey No 136 (as per the original call of Will H. Bonwell the locator) 340 vrs W of its N. E. corner. Please advise me if the Location of this S. W. Corner of Survey 23, and 9224 G. C. and S. F. R. R. Co. is the proper beginning point for these surveys. considering the changed positions the Blocks A. B. and D. ^(occupy) or should there be a connection ran from the East to locate this common corner of Surveys 23 and 24. You will by referring to the large sketch ^(see) that the S. E. corner of Survey 74 Blk D. Conflicts with the N. W. corner of Survey No 137 Blk B. 234 vrs Latitude and 413 Departure However if you will look at the excess in Surveys.

No 1-2-3-4 and 5 Blk D. which I found to exist between these identified
corners. by actual measurement, a total of 4270rs. would place the SE Corner
Blk D far below its represented position on the map of Sutton County.
Again I ran a connecting line from the S.W. corner of Survey 195 Block A
H.E. and W. J. R. Co. as established by W. B. Silliman and approved by W. D. Maddox
County Surveyor of Menard Co. See copy of field notes inclosed; Mr Silliman
continued this line South to the S.W. corner of this Block A, placing
corners at each mile, but never was approved by the C. L. O. I traced Mr Sill-
iman's survey of West-line of Blk A South to the old and made and
marked by him at S.W. corner of Survey 184, and found same to have been
measured ^(Collection 184) within one vara of the required distance between the SW Cor
^(Blk A) 195 and SW Cor 184 - 20900rs in conclusion I will ask you to please examine the in-
closed field notes and if found correct file same for patents and state how much
money will be necessary to patent ^(stating) the same. If not approved please
return all sketches with notes on same, the necessary corrections to be made
