Field Notes of the Survey of the
West boundary of Duval, and East boundary of
Ercinal County, made by the concurrent action of the
Commissioners Courts of Nueces, Duval and Webb
Counties, and the Surveyors of these Counties acting
under orders and instructions of the County Courts of
their respective Counties.

Beginning at a Mesquite post and pebble
mound set by the Surveyors of Live Oak, Nueces
Land Districts for the S.W. corner of McMullen County
the N.W. corner of Duval County, the N.E. corner of
Ercinal County and S.E. corner of La Salle County.
Said post is marked M on the N.E. side, D on the S.E.
side E on the S.W. side and L on the N.W. side, is
situated in an open valley with high land on all sides
except the North, and is about $3\frac{1}{4}$ miles from Steele's Rancho.

Thence South at 1900 varas the Maguayitos
Hill, the South white place, bears S. $84\frac{1}{4}$ ° W. Halls or
Bunkis Mott. bears N. $57\frac{3}{4}$ ° W. Solidad S. $20\frac{1}{2}$ ° E. at 2190
varas pass 730 varas East of the N.E. corner of Survey No. 345
and N.W. corner of Survey No. 344, at 3500 varas Maguayitos
Hill above mentioned bears West, at 3760 varas cross a
small Branch, at 5700 varas the 1st League 3rd mile
set a post marked 3 on the North side D on the East
and E on the West side.

Thence South, at 780 varas North Cheremusco
Creek, and the South fork of the same at 930

varas, at 1900 varas set a petrification, at 2256 varas pass ~~the~~
 varas ^{East} ~~West~~ of the S.W. corner of Survey No. 341, N.W. corner of Survey No.
 349, N.E. corner of No. 335 and S.E. corner of Survey No. 337, at
 2390 varas cross the old Corpus Christi and Eagle pass road,
 at 2840 varas set a post on the North side of the road to Fly's
 Ranche, at 5700 varas, the 2nd League 6th mile, set a post
 marked 6 on the North side near a Como Mott.

Thence South at 1400 varas cross Barranguito Creek
 at 1997 varas pass 68 varas East of the S.W. corner of Survey No. 332,
 at 2300 varas cross South fork of Barranguito Creek, at 3140
 varas cross a Branch at 5700 varas the 3rd League 9th mile
 set a post marked IX on the North side

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Thence South at 4885 varas Las Marchas Creek, at
 5700 varas the 4th League 12th mile set a post marked XII
 on the North side

Thence South at 4970 varas cross the Barrositas
 Creek, at 5700 varas the 5th League 15th mile, set a
 post marked XV on the North side.

Thence South, at 1865 varas Camel Hill bears
~~is 24 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E.~~ Parilla bears S. 17° E., Gt. Hermano S. 13 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W.
 at 3220 varas road from Alamito to San Diego, bears N. 85 $\frac{3}{4}$ ° E.
 at 3240 varas set a post, and built a stone mound and
 marked a rock down the East side and from the West side, at
 4356 varas pass 1411 varas West of the S.W. corner of Sur. No. 908
 made for the State of California, and N.W. corner of
 Survey No. 907 made for A. J. Neely as of Beatty's Seal & Surveyor
 at 5700 varas the 6th League 18th mile

Thence South, at 5700 varas the 7th League 21st mile

set a post marked ~~XXI~~ on the North side and a stone, whence a Mesquite marked V bears S. $10\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E. 61 varas, and a Canna marked ~~III~~ on the East side bears N. $3\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E. 108 varas, Palacios House at Solidad bears N. $3\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., Camel Hill S. $50\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E. and Panilla S. 31° E.

Thence South at 553 varas pass 116 varas West of the S.W. corner of Survey No. 913 made for Dr. J. Meuly. B.S. 47 and N.W. corner of Survey No. 912 made for State of Texas at 5700 varas the 8th League 240 kmile.

Thence South, at 257 varas pass 387 varas West of the S.W. corner of Survey No. 796 made for State of Texas and 57 varas West of the N.W. corner of Survey No. 794 made for the State of Texas. at 5700 varas the 9th League 27th mile set a post marked ~~XXVII~~ on the North side and built a mound of stone whence the North point of hill in Survey No. 790 for the State bears N. 42° E.

Thence South at 257 varas pass 1029 varas West of the N.E. corner of Survey No. 734 and 709 varas West of the S.W. corner of Survey No. 790 both made for the State at 350 varas pass 1145 varas West of the N.W. corner of Survey No. 406 made for the State at 5700 varas the 10th League, 30th mile set a post marked ~~XXX~~ on the North side D on the East side and E on the West side, also set 2 flint rocks, whence a Mesquite marked X bears S. 90° W. $82\frac{1}{2}$ varas, a low Mesquite on a hill bears N. $54\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W. and a low Mesquite on the N.E. point of a hill bears N. 26° W.

Thence South, at 257 varas pass 129 varas West of the S.E. corner of Survey No. 729 made for P. Martinez and 489 varas West of the N.E. corner of Survey No. 728 and

1195 varas West of the N.W. corner of Survey No. 404 both made
for the State, at 57000 varas the 11th League 33rd mile
Thence South, at 257 varas pass 1245 varas West of the
S.E. corner of Survey No. 167, made for L.P. Pena and S.W.
corner of Survey No. 168 made for the State, and 1199 varas
West of the N.W. corner of Survey No. 145 made for J.A. Flores,
at 4328 varas pass 574 varas West of the S.E. corner of Survey
No. 401, and N.W. corner of Survey No. 665 made for A. Leal,
and S.W. corner of Survey No. 666, and N.E. corner of Survey
No. 462, for the State., at 4475 varas set a rock on the
South side of the Laredo road from San Diego, at 5700
varas, set a stone marked DUV. 36 Mon the East side and
built a mound of stone near a Chapote Mott, for the 12th
League 36th mile

Thence South, at 57000 varas the 13th League 39th
mile, built a mound of stone in red soil whence H. Leal's
House bears N 42° W, and Loma Alta S. 25° W.

Thence South at 5517 varas ^{and built stone ground} set a rock _{on the South}
side of the old Corpus Christi and Laredo road, via Los
Angeles, at 57000 varas the 14th League, 42nd mile, set
a rock and built a stone mound whence Los Angeles bears
S 85 1/2° W.

Thence South at 320 varas, pass 3650 varas East of
the Rancho Los Angeles, at 2392 varas pass 1136 varas
West of Manuel Benavides Velas House, at 3840 varas set a
stone on the South side of the Carrizo road, at 57000 varas
the 15th League 45th mile set a rock and post marked
VX on the North side.

Run South at 1060 varas pass about 900 varas
West of Las Piedras de Lumbre, at 5700 varas the 16th
League 48th mile, set a post and flint rock where
a lone Mesquite bears S. $37\frac{1}{2}$ ° E.

This line was run with a variation of the needle.
The balance ^{11280 m} of this line ^{was} run at the time $9\frac{1}{2}$ ° E., and the trees along the line marked with four
hacks or notches.
