A.D. 1886. to meet the Surveyor from Llano County  
That I met Knight Stith Surveyor from Llano  
County & together we proceeded to carry out the  
orders of our respective Courts, I do further  
Certify that the above foregoing is a true & correct  
Copy of the field notes as made by us, that were  
accepted and placed of record in Mason &  
Llano Counties, with the exception, instead  
of calling for the number of varas from one  
mile station to another we called for yards, but  
that the measurements were entirely in varas  
originally, so this part of the field notes are changed  
that much, I certify further that the sketch  
sent you herewith showing the old original  
supposed line, which in reality does not  
exist on the ground never having been seen or  
measured, this old line marked in Black ink,  
and that the new line marked with red ink is a  
true & correct line, as seen by myself Stith  
as above set out, that it is platted on this sketch  
absolutely correct, that this work has been accepted  
by the County Commissioners Court of each County,  
I further certify that the mile posts put up on said  
new line are in all respects what the law requires.

Dear Sir:-

We hereby send you corrected field notes & measurements which explain themselves, As we consider this in all things complying with the requirements of the law, and as the County Commissioners Court of Mason Co. and the County Commissioners Court of Plano County, accepted the work, and as all parties interested are satisfied, and insisting that the abstracts be corrected according to the new line, as the old line marked in black ink is not on the ground, being entirely an imaginary line, and as the surveys & measurements show the new line to be correct. We hope & trust that you will examine the field notes and the sketch herewith sent you, showing the old imaginary as well as the ~~two~~ new line, and that you will see that it is for the best interest of both Mason & Plano Counties that said new line be accepted and the abstracts corrected to comply <sup>therewith</sup> and that all lands west of said new line be abstracted in Mason County Texs. It would be a very great hardship to compel Mason County & Plano County to rerun said line, when the result would be the same.
